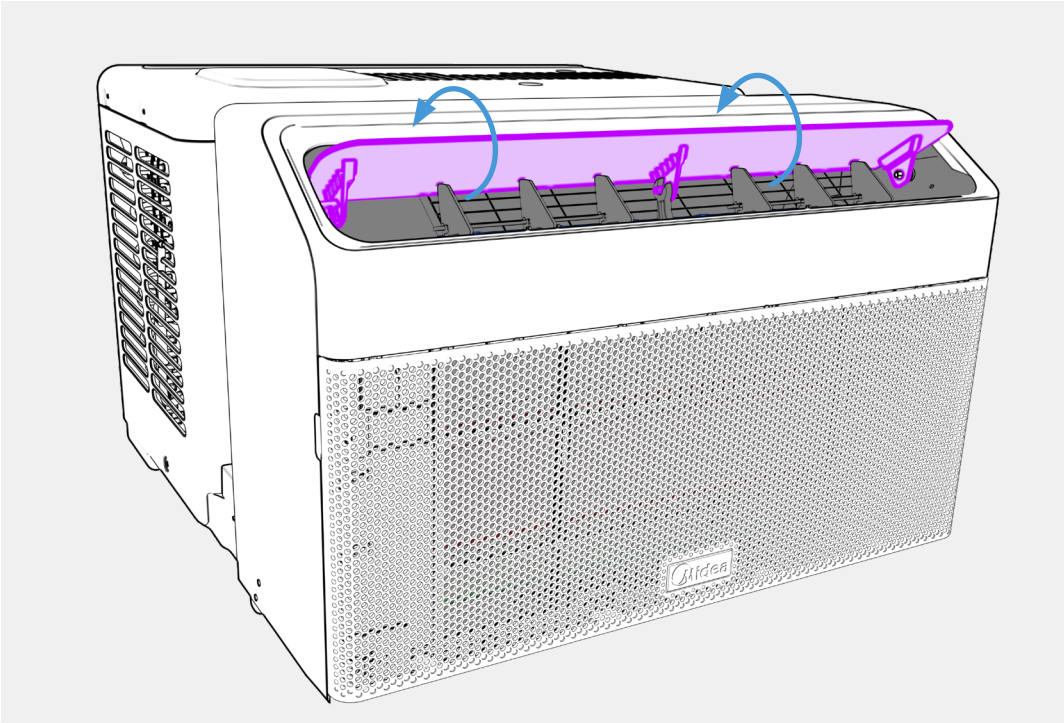


Unit Inspection

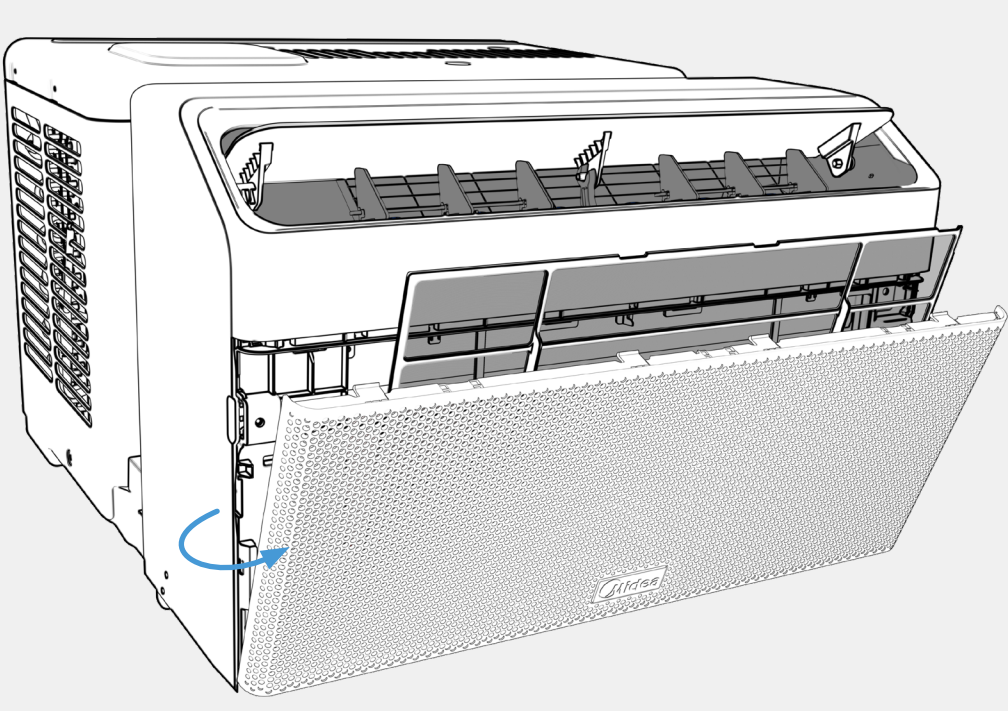
- ➔ Use the following steps to inspect your unit for mold, dust, and debris. If your unit does not show signs of build-up on the blue fan, gray fan housing, evaporator coil, or evaporator drain pan, you can continue to use the air conditioner until you receive and install the repair kit.
- ➔ If you’ve identified buildup of mold, dust, and debris, contact Midea for a one-time technician visit for cleaning.
- ➔ If you believe your product is unsafe to use, please contact Midea for a refund.

Inspection Steps

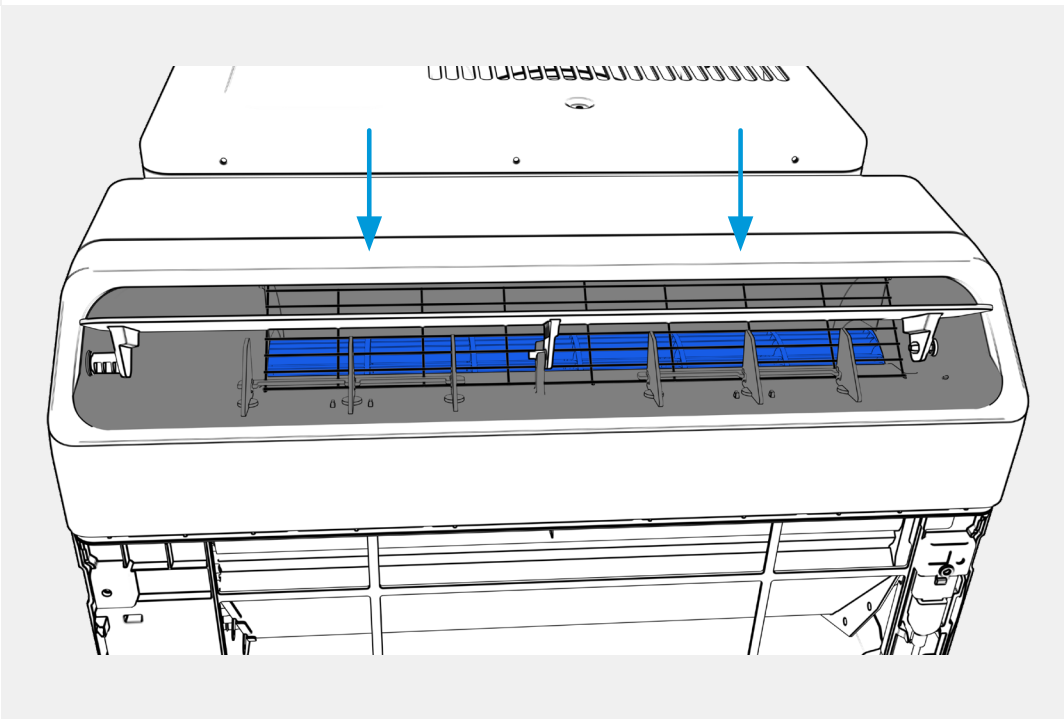
- Unplug the air conditioner.
- Rotate the louver (highlighted in purple) at the vent outlet to the fully open position.



- Remove the front grill by tilting forward and lifting.
- Remove the front black filter and inspect for dust and debris.
- Remove the bottom white filter if included in your model and inspect for dust and debris.



- Shine a flashlight into the vent outlet to inspect the fan (blue) and the fan housing (gray) for dust and debris.



- With the filter(s) removed, inspect the evaporator coil (highlighted in red) and evaporator drain pan (highlighted in green) beneath the coil for dust and debris.
- Reinstall the front grill and filter.
